

2. Organizing and Management

3. Participant Requirements and Admission Conditions

4.1 The competition is open to athletes from the Kyokushin-kan Organization.

4.2 Team Delegation Composition:

- Official Team Representative (Head of Delegation);
- Referees;
- Coaches;
- Athletes (**Maximum 4 participants per country** in each weight category).

4.3 Athletes aged **12 and older** with a grade of **8th Kyu or higher** are eligible to participate. The participant's age is determined as of **June 13, 2026**. Only athletes who have passed a medical examination and submitted a certificate from a sports medicine clinic (or a medical institution) will be admitted.

4.4 During registration, the team representative must submit the **original application form** (Appendix No. 1). Each athlete must provide the required personal documents:

- Passport;
- Doctor's stamp of approval to participate in competitions (in English), issued no earlier than June 1, 2026;
- HIV antibodies test certificate (in English), issued no earlier than June 1, 2026 (for adults only);
- HBV antibodies test certificate (in English), issued no earlier than June 1, 2026 (for adults only);
- HCV antibodies test certificate (in English), issued no earlier than June 1, 2026 (for adults only);
- Accident insurance contract valid at the time of the competition (original, in English);
- Application for participation in the Asian Championship – Appendix № 1.
- Written statement from the participant and statement from the parents – Appendix № 3 и 6

The original application, along with documents confirming medical clearance, must be submitted by the official team representative at the registration desk on **June 13, 2026**. **Photocopies will not be accepted!**

Dress Code Requirements:

- A clean white **dogi** with a belt corresponding to the athlete's qualification.

Mandatory Protective Equipment (Kumite):

All participants must have the following individual protective gear:

- **Boys (12-13, 14-15 years) and Juniors (16-17 years):**
 - **Mandatory:** Helmet, hand guards, shin/instep guards, groin guard.
 - *Optional:* Mouthguard.
- **Girls (12-13, 14-15 years) and Junior Girls (16-17 years):**
 - **Mandatory:** Helmet, hand guards, shin/instep guards, chest protector.
 - *Optional:* Mouthguard.
- **Men (18+ years):**
 - **Mandatory:** Groin guard.
 - *Optional:* Mouthguard.
- **Women (18+ years):**
 - **Mandatory:** Chest protector.
 - *Optional:* Mouthguard.

IMPORTANT: A mouthguard is **mandatory** for participants with dental braces!

ATTENTION! Violation of any of the above requirements will result in disqualification from the competition. All protective equipment is strictly individual!

Fight Duration (Time Limits)

- **Boys and Girls (12–13 years):**
 - **Preliminary rounds:** 2 min.+ 1 min. final extension;
 - **Semi-finals and Finals:** 2 min. + 1 min. extension + Weigh-in (difference > 2.5 kg) + 1 min. final extension.
- **Boys and Girls (14–15 years):**
 - **Preliminary rounds:** 2 min.+ 2 min. final extension;
 - **Semi-finals and Finals:** 2 min. + 2 min. extension + Weigh-in (difference > 2.5 kg) + 1 min. final extension.
- **Juniors (16–17 years):**
 - **Preliminary rounds:** 2 min. + 2 min. final extension;
 - **Semi-finals and Finals:** 2 min. + 2 min. extension + Weigh-in (difference > 2.5 kg) + 2 min. final extension.
- **Men and Women (18+ years):**
 - **Preliminary rounds:** 2 min. + 2 min. extension + 2 min. final extension;
 - **Semi-finals and Finals:** 3 min. + 2 min. extension + 2 min. final extension.

The participant's age is determined as of June 13, 2026.

Each category must have at least 3 participants; if the subgroup is not complete, the weight category will be combined into one subgroup. **In the event of an overweight or discrepancy between the age category of an athlete and the declared application (sent before May 13, 2026), as well as in the event of the declared athlete's refusal to participate in the competition or his removal by the coaching staff, or his absence from the tournament for any other reason, a fine is imposed on the team, based on 1 entry fee for each absent athlete.**

It is prohibited for one athlete to participate in several categories.

5. Application for Participants

Preliminary applications (Appendix No. 1) and the list of judges (Appendix No. 2) are accepted until May 20, 2026!

Submission Requirements

At the **Credentials Committee (Admission Commission)**, the team representative must provide the **original application form** (Appendix No. 1). The application for participation must be stamped and signed by the head of the national Kyokushin-kan federation.

Medical Certification

The basis for an athlete's admission to the competition is a **medical report** with the note "**Cleared**" next to each athlete's name. This must be:

- Certified by the signature and personal stamp of a sports medicine physician (including full name).
- Certified by the stamp of a medical organization licensed to perform medical activities.
- *Alternatively:* An individual medical certificate signed by a physician and stamped by the medical organization is acceptable.
- The doctor must write out the **total number of admitted athletes in words**.

Important: The date of medical clearance must be no earlier than **June 1, 2026**.

Attention! The application form and individual medical certificates must contain **original signatures and stamps**. Documents with facsimile signatures or scanned/digital stamps will **not** be accepted!

6. Awards

Kumite competitions are held according to the elimination system after one defeat.

- In each weight category, there are two third places among women and men (fights for 3rd place are not held).
- In each weight category, there are two third places among boys, girls, juniors (fights for 3rd place are not held).

Kata competitions are held in two rounds, with the 4 best scores advancing to the final round:

- In each age category, there are two third places among women and men
- In each age category, there are two third places among boys, girls, juniors

Winners and prizewinners (1st-3rd places) are awarded with medals and diplomas as well as cups of corresponding grade.

The **reporting final documents** of the Asian Championship are sent electronically to representatives of all participating countries.

7. Financial Conditions

Entry Fees:

- **Kumite:** \$100
- **Kata:** \$100

Note: If an athlete is participating in both categories, you may want to clarify if they pay \$150 total or if there is a discount.

Travel, accommodation, and meal expenses are to be covered by the sending organizations.
